Explanation of Services

Professional & Staff Services:

Coordinating Activities, Rites and Ceremonies

- Includes 24-hour staff availability, initial pre or at need arrangements and aftercare. This fee also covers the costs associated with taxes, insurance and licences.
- Professional consultation with a Class One Licenced Funeral Director, including, but not limited to, expert advice on options to meet your needs, and to accompany you through out the provided services.
- Co-ordination of all activities, rites and ceremonies, before, during and after they have been provided. Co-ordination of services and supplies provided by us, as well as those provided by third party suppliers, such as florists and newspapers (death notices). \$1425

Documentation – Permits, Forms etc...

- Completion and filing of all documents (not including applicable fees associated to certain forms) necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested, including, but not limited to, death registration, burial permit, coroner's certificate for cremation and/or documentation necessary to transfer the deceased out of the country.
- Provision of 8 Proof of Death Certificates issued by Bocchinfuso Funeral Home Inc.
- Also included:
 - ✓ Cancellation of all government cards (SIN, Health Card, OAS Card, Pleasure Craft Operator Card, Outdoors Card [Fishing and Hunting Licence])

Transportation of Deceased Remains (within 25kms; additional fee applies beyond 25kms)

- Staff services for transportation of remains from one place to another. For example, from a hospital to the funeral home, or from the funeral home to the cemetery, mausoleum or crematorium. A charge applies for each transportation request. \$395

Basic Preparation of Deceased Remains

(Requires Facilities for Preparation/Embalming/ Shelter)

- The preparation of the body for placement into the casket, including bathing, dressing and the setting of facial features for identification or viewing without embalming and checking remains for personal effects, jewellery and pacemaker. This charge applies whenever we handle deceased remains, and additional personal protective equipment when necessary. \$250

Embalming of Deceased Remains and Preparation for Viewing

(In addition to Basic Preparation of Remains)

- Embalming is a process of sanitation, restoration, and temporary preservation. Embalming is not legally required but may be recommended to preserve the body between the time of death and the visitation or disposition of the deceased. Our professional funeral directors will make a recommendation based on the condition of the body and expected service needs.
- Includes dressing, casketing, basic hairdressing, grooming and cosmetics \$395

Refundable Cremated Remains Deposit

Applicable when we are asked to store cremated remains for any period longer than two weeks. If the cremated remains are not claimed within one year of the cremation, the deposit may be used to inter the cremated remains in common ground. If the cremated remains are claimed before they are interred, the deposit will be refunded. \$350

DISBURSEMENTS

Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf, by the funeral home. You are expected to pay for these items at the time the contract is entered into. The following are some items that are often identified as disbursements:

Coroner's Fee: This is a fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation to take place. The fee is set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario.

Clergy Honourarium: This is an amount paid to the clergy for their services. In some cases, the amount is set by the clergy – considered a "Clergy Fee", in other cases, it is an amount to be determined by you and would be considered an honourarium or offering.

Newspaper Notices: These are charges for death notices placed in newspapers.

Luncheons: The funeral home can arrange for a luncheon following your services.

Cemetery Fees: The cemetery, chosen by the family, charges a set fee for the opening and closing of the grave, and may have additional weekend or holiday charges. Each cemetery has different set amounts. Cemetery fees must be paid directly to the cemetery.

Municipal Death Registration Fee: This fee is charged by the local municipality to register the death. The fee is set by the municipality.

Cremation/Aquatorium Fee: Price set by crematorium/aquatorium of your choice.

Bereavement Authority of Ontario Consumer Protection Fee: The fee is charged by the Bereavement Authority of Ontario (BAO) in order to provide its services of information on your options in bereavement services and to regulate the profession making sure the law is consistently followed. Please read the BAO's free Consumer Information Guide on its website or in print

PAYMENT, FINANCING AND FUNDING

At Need Payment: The Purchaser will be required to make a 30% deposit at the time of signing the contract for funeral services plus any cash disbursements. The balance of the contract is due within 16 days of signing the contract. Payment may be made by cash, cheque or money order.

Pre-Paid Arrangement Payment: When prepaying, you pay for the services and supplies today. The funds deposited plus the interest accrued will be used to pay for the services and supplies when they are delivered at the time of death. If there is any money left due to the interest earned, it will be refunded to the estate. A T-5 will also be issued. Should you cancel the contract after 30 days, you will be charged an administration fee in the amount of 10% of the prepayment funds, up to a maximum of \$350.00.

Trust: You make your payment in full to us or provide a cancelled cheque for monthly payments and we will place this money in a trust account where it will accrue interest until the contract is fulfilled (when services and supplies are delivered) or the contract is cancelled.

Insurance: You may purchase an insurance contract where the proceeds of the insurance contract will be used to pay for the services or supplies at the time they are delivered, or the contract is cancelled.
